1.0 Introduction

The economy of Lesotho is mostly dependent on agriculture. The type of agriculture practiced is mainly subsistence. Agriculture is practiced across ten districts of Lesotho and covers four ecological zones; Lowlands, Foothills, Mountain and Senqu River Valley (SRV). The Lowlands zone is the most densely populated and intensively cultivated with relatively high chances of rainfall. The Foothills zone as compared to Lowlands is less populated and has low rainfall. The Mountain zone is the largest zone of the country that is characterized by very cold winter, thus allowing only summer cropping. SRV is the smallest zone which runs from the east along the valleys of the Senqu River. SRV is characterized by low rainfall especially in the South Western part.

The Bureau of Statistics (BOS) provides agricultural statistics which are collected through Annual Agricultural Production Survey (APS) which runs through an Agricultural Year starting from the 01st August to 31st July of the following year. The 2018/2019 Livestock Statistics Report contains information on farming household characteristics, livestock inventory, main purpose for keeping livestock as well as mortality and stock change.

1.1 Methodology

The section covers sampling methods and data collection.

1.1.1 Sampling Method

A stratified multi-stage sampling scheme was adopted for the selection of the sample for 2018/2019 Agricultural Year. Two or more enumeration areas were combined to constitute Primary Sampling Units (PSUs) and agricultural holdings (farming households) constitute Secondary Sampling Units (SSUs). Agricultural Production Survey covered 100 PSUs in the rural areas, where each PSU covered an average of about 17 selected households through systematic sampling. The PSUs have been selected with Probability Proportional to Size (PPS) where number of households were taken as measure of size.

The agricultural holdings must meet one or more of the following conditions:

- (i) Rearing one or more cattle,
- (ii) Rearing at least one goat or sheep,
- (iii) Fifty improved chicken,
- (iv) One improved pig.

1.1.2 Data Collection

Data was collected through face-to-face interview by Field Assistants (enumerators) who were posted in selected PSUs under the supervision of Field Officers and Senior Field Officers. The enumerators are encouraged and advised, where possible, to arrive in the early morning to do the counting of stock together with owners while the animals are still present in their kraals and shelters. Only

livestock found in household's possession including those at the cattle posts during enumeration were counted. The animals that were mafisad¹-out were not included as they were enumerated as mafisad-in with other households. Data collection was done in three phases, the first phase was collection of household characteristics and livestock Inventory, second phase was on mortality and stock change after six months and the third phase was on inventory, mortality and stock change also collected six months later.

¹ Mafisad-in/out is when livestock is fully managed by another household which does not own it

2.0 Results and Findings

The chapter on results covers on detailed information on household characteristics for livestock holdings and livestock inventory classified by sex and age, mortality and causes of deaths as well as stock change showing the causes of the increases and decreases in the stock of animals.

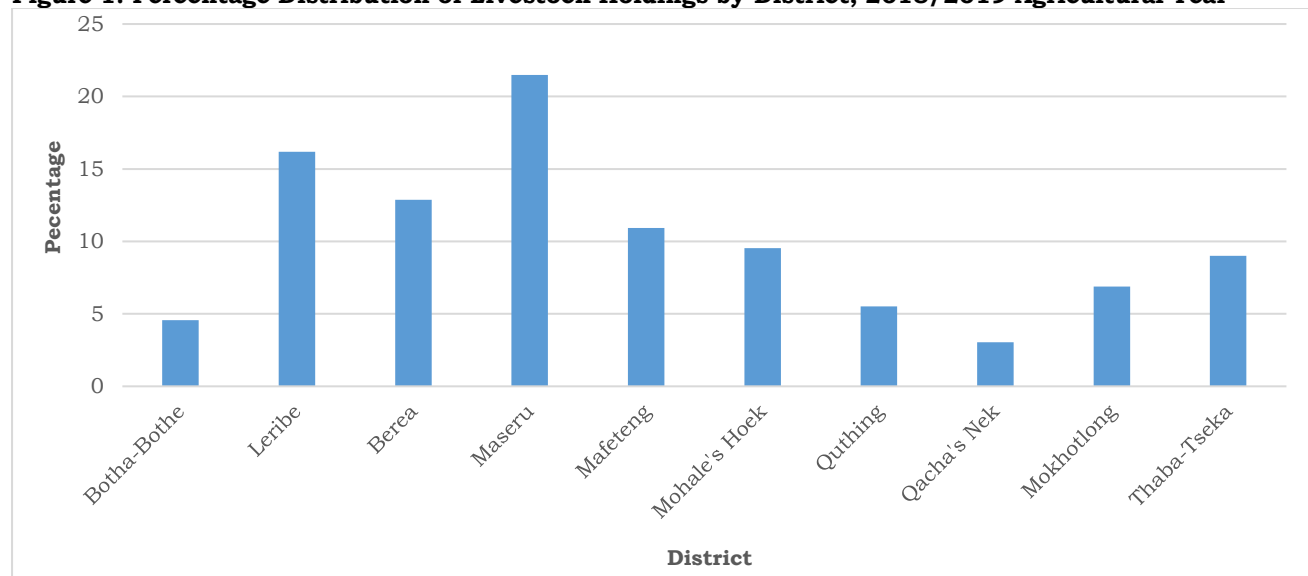
2.1 Household Composition

The section covers the household characteristics for the livestock holdings for 2018/2019 Agricultural Year. It includes age, sex, educational attainment, main activity, contribution to farming, residential status as well as management and decision making on livestock.

2.1.1 Agricultural Holdings

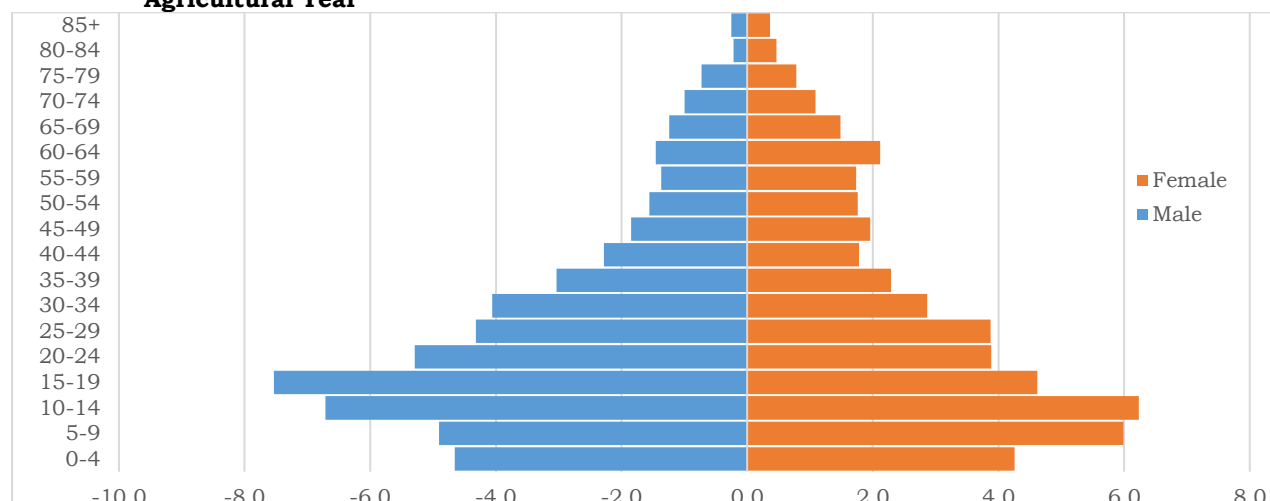
Figure 1: Percentage Distribution of Livestock Holdings by District, 2018/2019 Agricultural Year

An agricultural holding is an economic unit of agricultural production under single management comprising all livestock kept and all land used wholly or partly for agricultural production purposes, without regard to title, legal form or size. Figure 1 portrays the percentage distribution of livestock holdings. During the year, there were about 10,1772 holdings. Most holdings were found in Maseru (21.5 percent) followed by Leribe (16.2 percent) while Qacha's Nek was lowest with 3.1 percent.

2.1.2 Agricultural Household Members

Figure 2 presents the distribution for agricultural household members by age and sex. In the livestock farming holdings, there were 522,982 persons in which 52.5 percent were males. The age groups "10-14" and "15-19" were populated with 12.9 percent and 12.2 percent respectively for both sexes. It is also shown that from age groups "0-4" to "40-44", there are more males than females except for age group "5-9" where females were more than males by 1.1 percent. However, from ages "45- 49" to 85 years and above, there were more females than males.

2.1.3 Relationship Status

The relationship status refers to the relationship of other household members to the head of the holding. A household head is a person who makes major decisions regarding use and exercises management control over the agricultural holding operations. Table 1 presents the relationship status of agricultural household members to the household head. It is shown that the larger portion of members related to household heads were sons and daughters (36.2 percent). About 11.3 percent of the members were spouses to the household heads while 19.0 percent were grandchildren and great grandchildren.

2.1.4 Educational Attainment

Educational attainment refers to the highest level of formal education completed by an individual. Table 2 gives the distribution of agricultural household members by educational attainment and sex. In the table, it is shown that most members have completed Primary school level, constituting 60.6 percent. There were 18.2 percent of males and 10.9 percent of females have not completed any

level. About 25.8 percent of females have completed High school level. There were few Graduates constituting 0.3 percent with Diploma holders or Certificate or Vocational training after Secondary school or High school at 1.0 percent.

2.1.5 Residential Status

The section relates to the usual place of residence for each member in the household. Table 3 shows the residential status of agricultural household members by district. Majority (85.0 percent) of the members declared their usual place of residence as present, meaning that they are usually staying in their own households. About 21.0 percent and 22.8 percent of the population of Maseru were present elsewhere in Lesotho (22.8). Leribe had most persons residing in RSA (24.5 percent) and outside Lesotho and RSA (80.5 percent).

2.1.6 Main Activity Status

Main activity determines activeness of the person's usual economic status. Table 4 gives percentage distribution of agricultural household members by main activity and sex. The table refers only to members aged 10 years and above. The table shows that employers constituted 0.2 percent. About 20.1 percent and 9.2 percent of males and females were subsistence farmers respectively. Most females were housewives constituting to 35.6 percent.

2.1.7 Contribution to Farming

Contribution to farming refers to household members participating in the agricultural activities of the holding. Table 5 presents the distribution of agricultural household members who had contributed to agricultural activities during 2018/2019. It is shown that male members contributed more than females. For those who participated, 31.2 percent contributed for a period of (0-3 months) and 21.6 percent for more than 10 months.

2.1.8 Management and Decision Making

It is not in every case that the household head will manage or make decision regarding certain agricultural operations in the holding. In a holding, other household members apart from the household head may own livestock, i.e. sub-holder. Apart from the household head, a sub-holder can also make decision on some agricultural operations in that holding.

Therefore, Table 6 gives percentage distribution of agricultural household members owning livestock by management and sex. In general, 115,229 of 522,982 holders owned livestock and 120,272 of 522,982 managed livestock. There were about 60.0 and 24.5 percent of males and females respectively who owned and managed livestock simultaneously. About 2.1 percent females managed livestock which they did not own. On the other hand, 8.4 and 7.1 percent of males and females respectively own but do not manage livestock.

Table 7 shows percentage distribution of household members owning livestock by decision making and sex for 2018/2019 Agricultural Year. It is observed from the table that 65.2 and 29.4 percent male and female holders respectively do make decisions on the holding's livestock. However, 3.2 percent and 2.2 percent males and females respectively owned some livestock but have no decision on them.

2.2 Cattle Inventory

The section covers cattle distribution, purpose of keeping cattle, their mortality and stock change. The distribution is categorized by sex and age.

2.2.1 Cattle Distribution

Table 8 presents the number of cattle by district, age and sex. It is shown that there were 360,602 cattle in the country, out of which 58.3 percent were female. Majority of them were aged 2 years and above (165,851). Maseru had the highest number (76,360) of cattle followed by Leribe with 69,246 while Qacha's Nek was lowest at 9,642.

Figure 3 portrays cattle distribution from 2014/2015 to 2018/2019 Agricultural Years. There had been a decline in the heads of cattle from 2014/2015 to 2018/2019. The highest decline of 20.5percent was observed in 2018/2019 Agricultural year from 453,297 of the previous year.

Figure 3: Number of Cattle ('000), 2014/2015 to 2018/2019 Agricultural Years

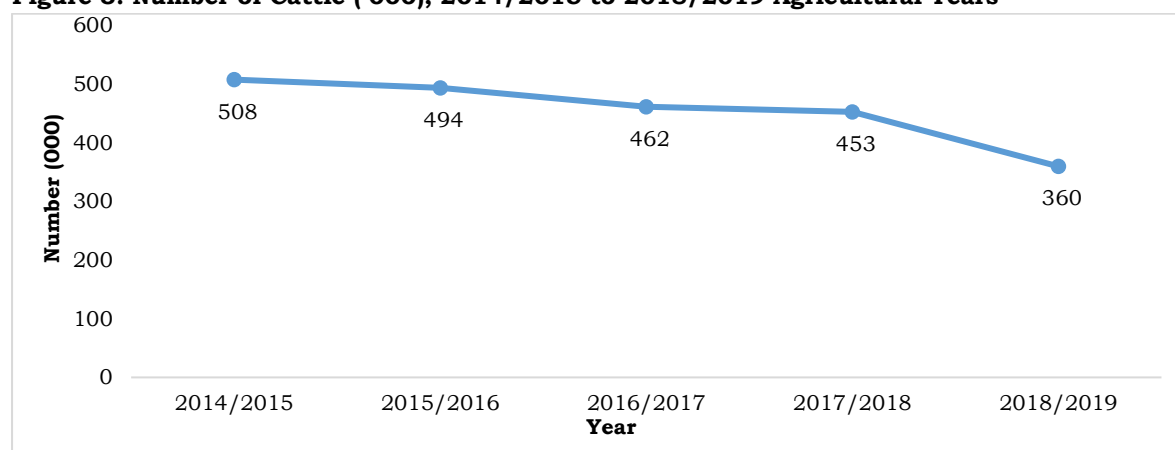


Table 9 shows percentage distribution of cattle by district, type and main purpose of keeping cattle. According to the table most cows were kept for “Meat” (85.4 percent) while 10.8 percent were kept for draught power. About 51.2 percent of oxen were kept for draught power. Furthermore, Mafeteng had 45.6 percent of draught power cows, followed by Mokhotlong with 25.9 percent. It

further shows that Berea had most bulls (18.2 percent), followed by Leribe and Maseru with 17.4 and 17.0 percent respectively.

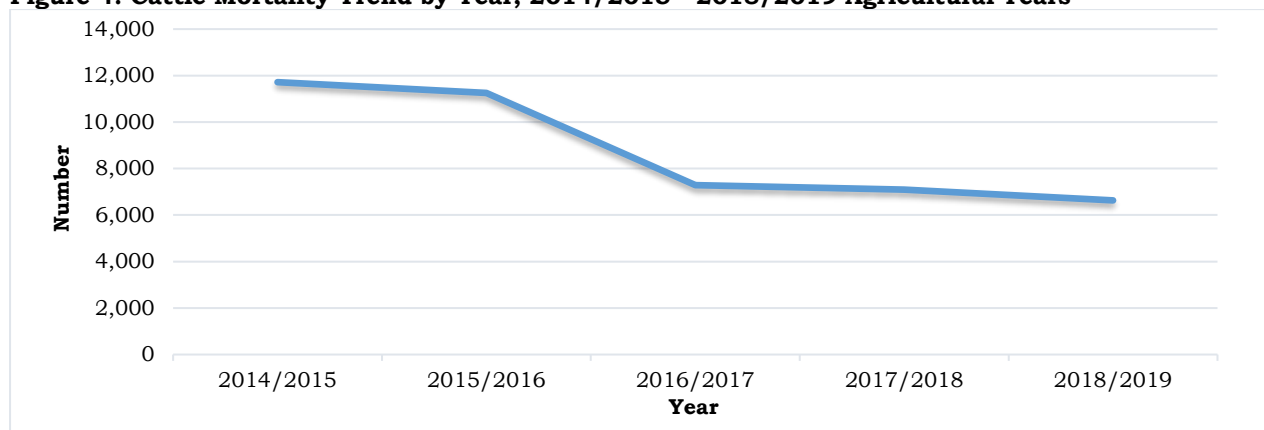
2.2.2 Cattle Mortality

Mortality refers to deaths due to diseases. Table 10 shows number of cattle by zone and type of diseases for 2018/2019 Agricultural Year. Most cattle had died due to Pulpy kidney (1,460), of which 37.9 percent was experienced in the Foothills. It is also shown that 1,192 cattle died of Anaplasmosis and 47.7 percent were in the Mountains.

Figure 4 depicts the trend for cattle mortality. It is shown that from 2014/2015 to 2018/2019 Agricultural year mortality had been decreasing. The highest deaths were experienced in 2014/2015 (11,717 cattle) died and thereafter it declined by 35.2 percent from 2015/2016 to 2016/2017, followed by a decrease of 2.6 percent in 2017/2018 and 6.6 percent in 2018/2019 Agricultural Year.

2.2.3 Cattle Diseases Treatment

Table 11 shows number of livestock holdings which treated cattle against diseases for 2018/2019 Agricultural Year. About 60.4 percent of the holdings treated for cattle diseases. Leribe and Maseru had about, 8,798 and 8,478 cattle which were treated respectively, followed by Berea with 13.3 percent while Qacha's Nek was lowest with 2.5 percent.

2.2.4 Cattle Stock Change

Table 12 shows the percentage distribution on the change in stock of cattle. According to the table, there had been increases and declines in stock of cattle for some districts. Cattle population of Quthing increased by 10.1 percent followed by Qacha's Nek with 5.4 percent. The highest decline was in Mokhotlong (13.2 percent) followed by Thaba-Tseka with 7.0 percent.

2.3 Sheep Inventory

Sheep inventory entails distribution of Sheep, their mortality and stock change. Sheep age group are classified into less than one year and those one year and above.

2.3.1 Sheep Distribution

Sheep distribution by district, age and sex is shown in Table13. There were 1,539,855 sheep during the 2018/2019 Agricultural Year, out of which Maseru had the highest number (296,659) while Qacha's Nek was lowest (41,228). Female sheep had out-numbered males in both age categories and about 55.3 percent the sheep were females aged one year and above.

Figure 5: Sheep Population ('000) Trend by Year, 2014/2015 -2018/2019 Agricultural Years

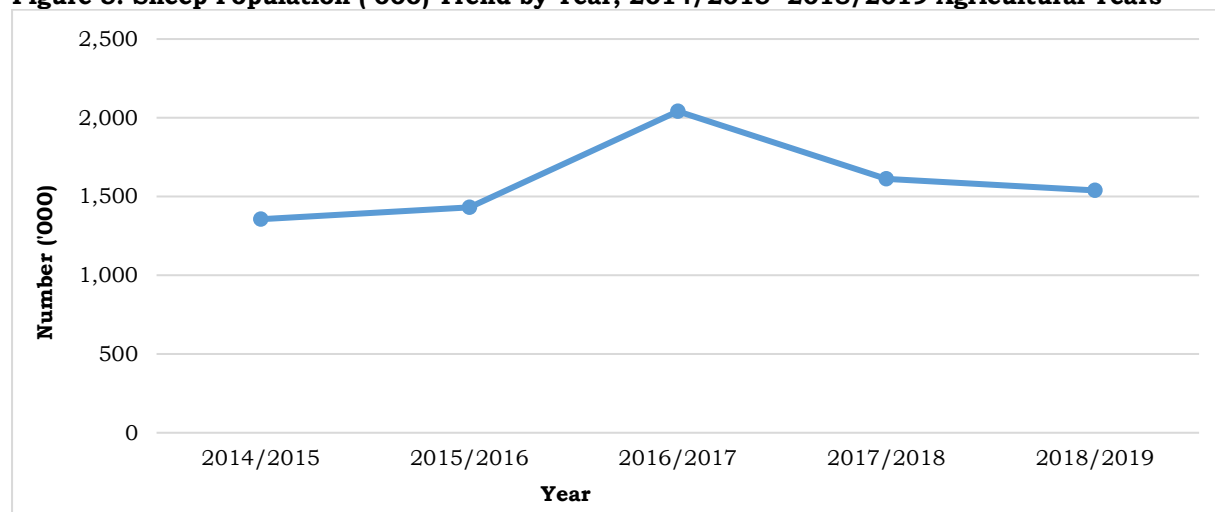
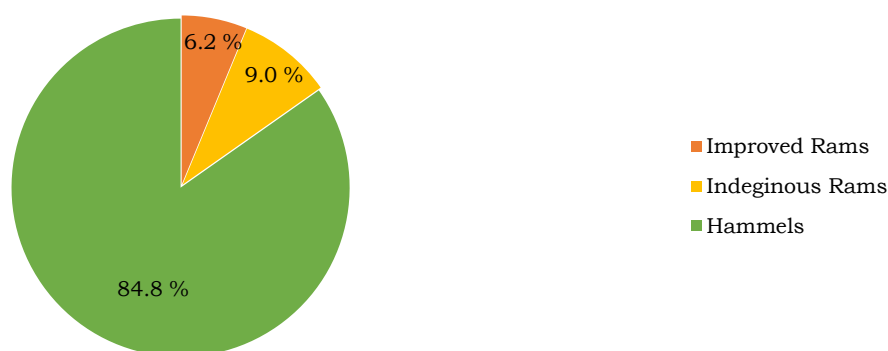

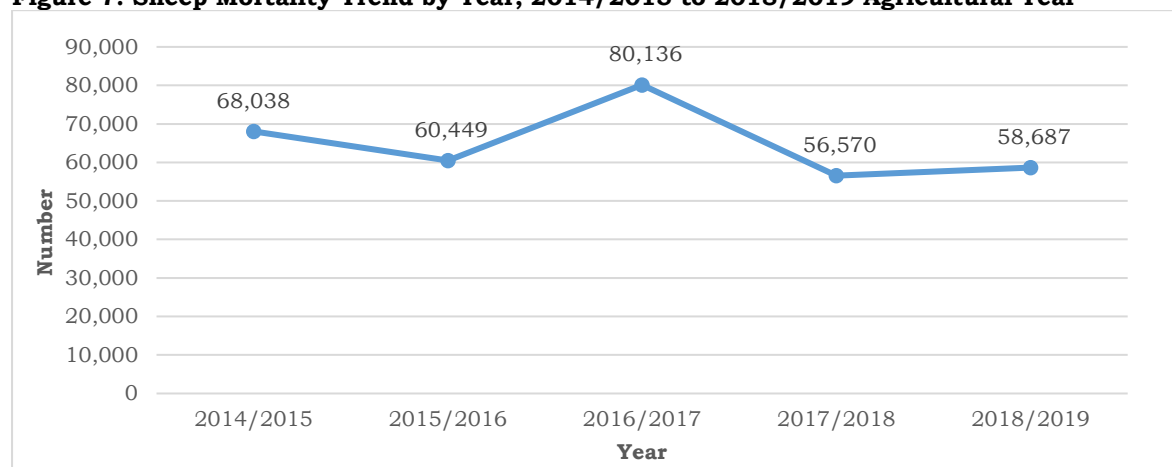

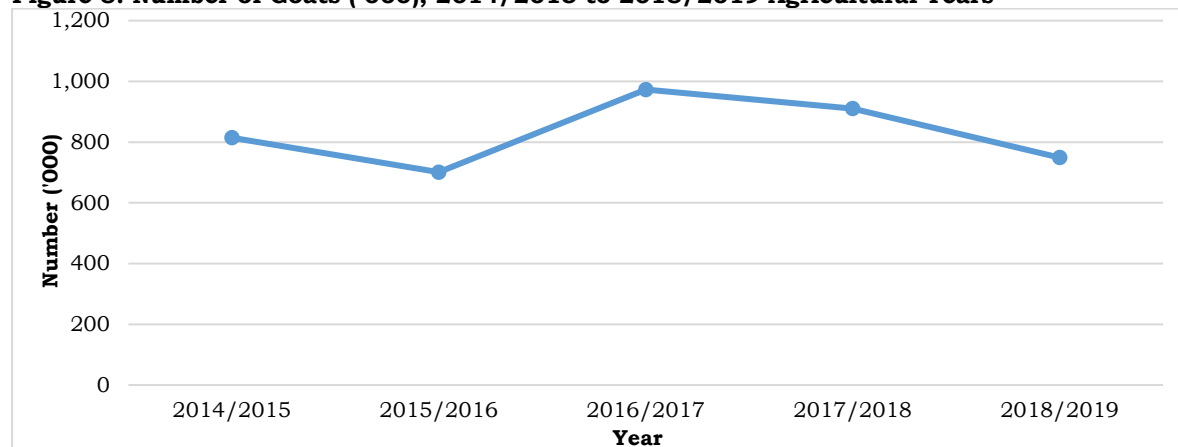

Figure 8: Number of Goats ('000), 2014/2015 to 2018/2019 Agricultural Years



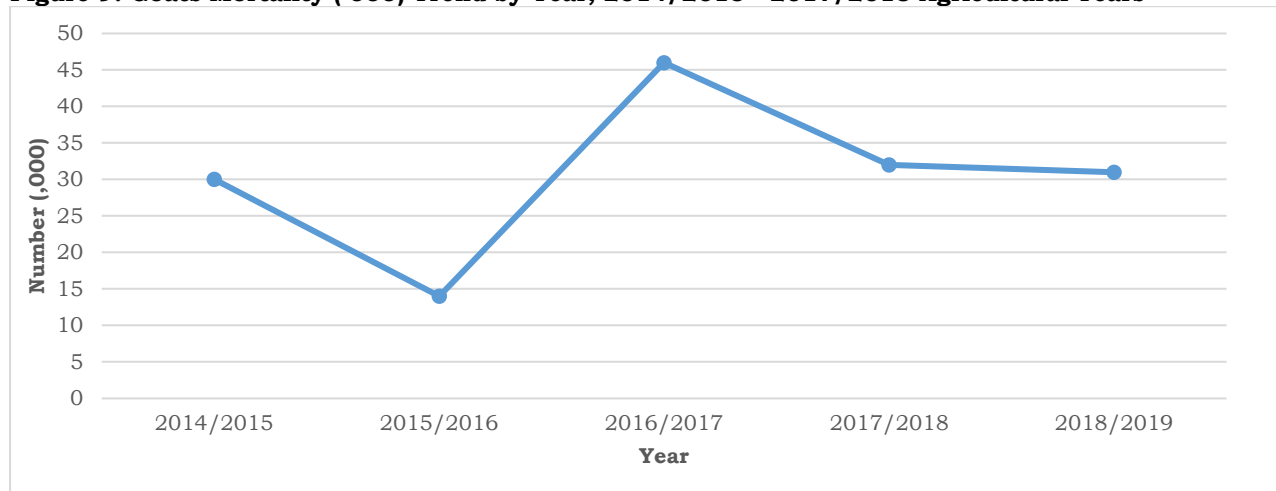

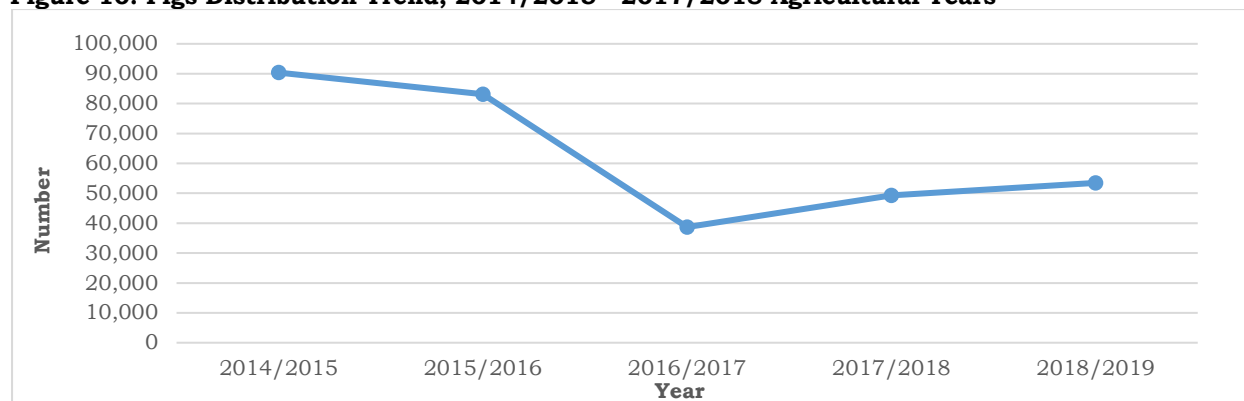

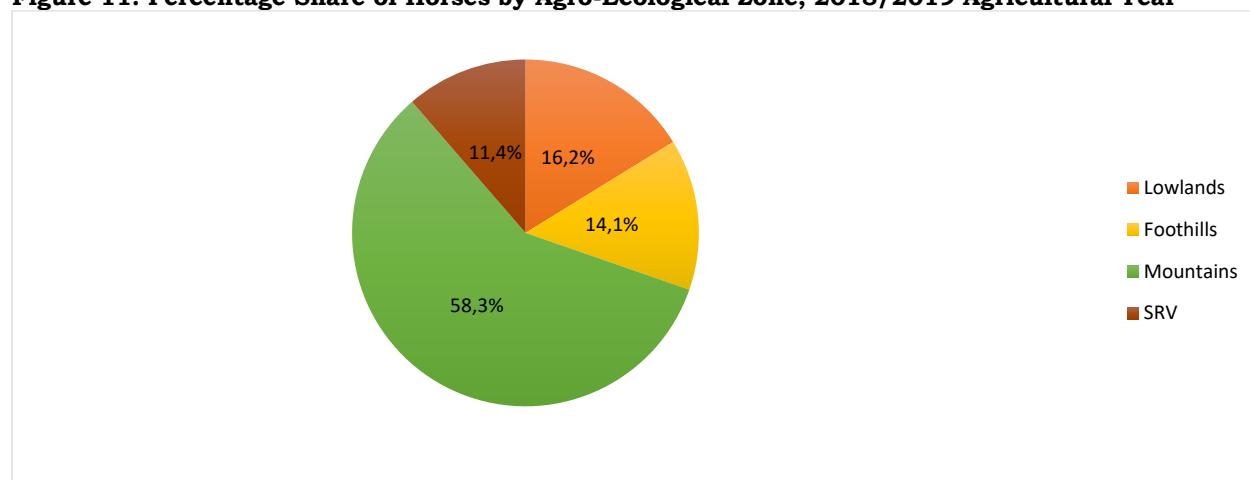

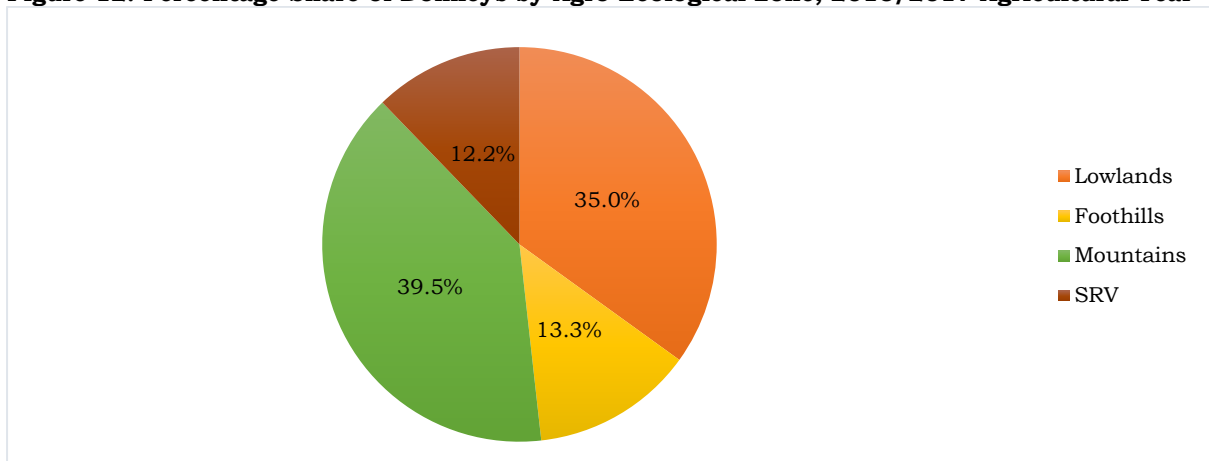

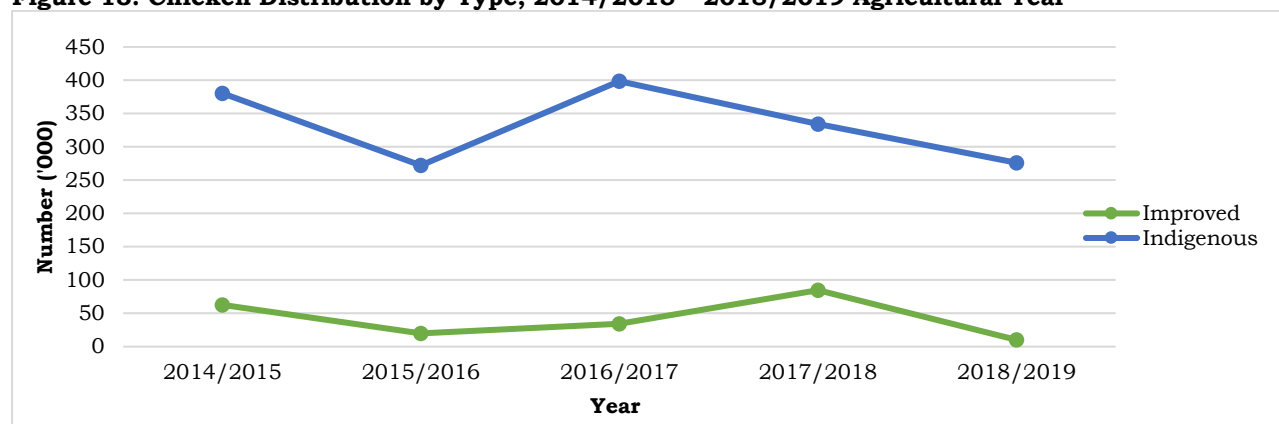
