## LIVESTOCK STATISTICS REPORT 2019/2020



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## **1.0 Introduction**

The economy of Lesotho is mostly dependent on agriculture. The type of agriculture practiced is mainly subsistence. Agriculture is practiced in all four ecological zones; Lowlands, Foothills, Mountain and Senqu River Valley (SRV) across ten districts of Lesotho. The Lowlands zone is the most densely populated and intensively cultivated with relatively high chances of rainfall. The Foothills zone as compared to Lowlands is less populated and has low rainfall. The Mountain zone is the largest zone of the country that is characterized by very cold winter, thus allowing only summer cropping. SRV is the smallest zone which runs from the east along the valleys of the Senqu River. SRV is characterized by low rainfall especially in the South Western part.

The Bureau of Statistics (BOS) provides agricultural statistics which are collected through Annual Agricultural Production Survey (APS) which runs through an Agricultural Year starting from the 01<sup>st</sup> August to 31<sup>st</sup> July of the following year. The 2019/2020 Livestock Statistics Report contains information on farming household characteristics, livestock inventory, main purpose for keeping livestock as well as mortality and stock change.

## **1.1 Methodology**

The section covers sampling methods and data collection.

### **1.1.1 Sampling Method**

A stratified multi-stage sampling scheme was adopted for the selection of the sample for 2019/2020 Agricultural Year. Two or more enumeration areas were combined to constitute Primary Sampling Units (PSUs) and agricultural holdings (farming households) constitute Secondary Sampling Units (SSUs). Agricultural Production Survey covered 100 PSUs in the rural areas, where each PSU covered an average of about 17 selected households through systematic sampling. The PSUs have been selected with Probability Proportional to Size (PPS) where number of households were taken as measure of size.

The agricultural holdings must meet one or more of the following conditions:

- (i) Rearing at least one or more cattle,
- (ii) Rearing at least one goat or sheep,
- (iii) Fifty improved chicken,

(iv) One improved pig.

### **1.1.2 Data Collection**

Data was collected through face-to-face interview by Field Assistants (enumerators) who were posted in selected PSUs under the supervision of Field Officers and Senior Field Officers. The enumerators are encouraged and advised, where possible, to arrive in the early morning to do the counting of livestock together with owners while the animals are still present in their kraals and shelters. Only livestock found in household's possession including those at the cattle posts during enumeration were counted. The animals that were mafisad<sup>1</sup>-out were not included as they were enumerated as mafisad-in with other households. Data collection was done in three phases; the first phase was data collection on household characteristics and livestock inventory, second phase was on mortality and stock change after six months and the third phase was on inventory, mortality and stock change also collected six months later.

## **2.0 Results and Findings**

The chapter on results covers detailed information on household characteristics for livestock holdings and livestock inventory classified by sex and age, mortality and causes of deaths as well as stock change showing the causes of the increases and decreases in the stock of animals.

### **2.1 Household Composition**

The section covers the household characteristics for the livestock holdings for 2019/2020 Agricultural Year. It includes age, sex, educational attainment and main activity, contribution to farming, residential status of household members as well as management and decision making on livestock.



### 2.1.1 Agricultural Holdings


**Figure 1: Percentage Distribution of Livestock Holdings by District, 2019/2020 Agricultural Year**

An agricultural holding is an economic unit of agricultural production under single management comprising all livestock kept and all land used wholly or partly for agricultural production purposes, without regard to title, legal form or size. Figure 1 portrays the percentage distribution of livestock holdings. During the year, there were about 272,357 holdings. Most holdings were found in Berea (13.7 percent) followed by Leribe (13.6 percent) while Botha-Bothe was lowest with 4.8 percent.

### 2.1.2 Agricultural Household Members

Figure 2 presents the distribution for agricultural household members by age and sex. In the livestock farming holdings, there were 727,184 persons of which 430,474 were males and 296,709 females. About 9.7 percent and 9.2 percent were aged “10-14” and “15-19” year respectively. It is also shown that there were more females than males at age 10-14 and age 85+ years.

### 2.1.3 Relationship Status

The relationship status refers to the relationship of other household members to the head of the holding. A household head is a person who makes major decisions regarding use and exercises management control over the agricultural holding operations. Table 1 presents the relationship status of agricultural household members to the 272,357 household heads. It is shown that 37.5 percent of the farming population were households heads, followed by sons and daughters at 29.2 percent. The grandchildren to household heads were 101,920. About 9.5 percent were spouses to the household heads.

### 2.1.4 Educational Attainment

Educational attainment refers to the highest level of formal education completed by an individual. Table 2 gives the distribution of agricultural household members by educational attainment and sex. The table shows that 62.2 percent of the household members have attained primary school level. About 15.5 percent have not completed any level of education while about 0.7 percent were graduates. Most males have attained primary school level (62.0 percent) followed by males who have not attained any educational level (20.3 percent). About 62.6 percent of females have attained primary level followed 25.2 percent of females who have attained high school level.

### 2.1.5 Residential Status

The section relates to the usual place of residence for each member in the household. Table 3 shows the residential status of agricultural household members by district. Majority (87.3 percent) of the members reported their usual place of residence as present, meaning that they were usually staying in their own households. About 8.6 percent of members lived in Republic of South Africa (RSA) while 0.2 percent lived outside “Lesotho and RSA”. About 23.2 percent of the members who lived in RSA were from Leribe and 30.9 percent of the members who resided outside “Lesotho and RSA” were from Qacha’s Nek.

### 2.1.6 Main Activity Status

Main activity determines activeness of the person’s usual economic status. Table 4 gives percentage distribution of household members by main activity and sex. The table refers only to members aged 10 years and above which is the population which is believed to be economically active. The table shows that 27.1 percent of population were involved in subsistence farming. The table also reveals that most males (37.0 percent) were subsistence farmers while males (37.0 percent) were housewives.

### 2.1.7 Contribution to Farming

Contribution to farming refers to household members participating in the agricultural activities of the holding. Table 5 presents the distribution of agricultural household members who contributed to the agricultural activities during 2019/2020. It is shown that 180,233 household members contributed to farming for more than 10 months, out of which 77.8 percent were males and 22.2 percent were females. It is further shown that 25.3 percent of the household members did not contribute to farming at all and most of them were females (53.1 percent).

### 2.1.8 Management and Decision Making

It is not in every case that household heads will always manage or make decision regarding certain agricultural operations in the holding. In a holding, other household members apart from the household head may own livestock, i.e., sub-holder or make decisions on the agricultural activities.

Table 6 presents the percentage distribution of males and females who made decision on livestock in 2019/2020 agricultural year by districts. The table shows that there were 317,245 decision makers, out of which 83.2 percent were males and 16.8 percent were females. Mafeteng had the higher percentage (22.7 percent) of females who made decisions on livestock followed by Quthing with 22.6 percent.

Table 7 presents the number of household members who managed livestock in 2019/2020 Agricultural Year by district and sex. The table shows that there were 234,314 household members who managed livestock, out of which 176,245 were

males and 58,070 were females. Berea had the highest number of both male (30,246) and female (8,832) household members who managed livestock. Qacha's Nek had the lowest number of both male (5,411) and female (1,938) members who managed livestock..

Table 8 presents the number of household members who owned livestock during 2019/2020 agricultural year by the type of livestock and sex of the owner. The table shows that there were 308,846 household members who owned livestock of which 228,922 were males and 79,924 were females. It is shown that the highest number of members (84,313) owned cattle followed by those who owned sheep (63,980).

## 2.2 Cattle Inventory

The section covers cattle distribution by age and sex, purpose of keeping cattle, their mortality and stock change.

### 2.2.1 Cattle Distribution

Table 9 presents cattle population by district, age and sex for 2019/2020 Agricultural Year. There were 330,726 cattle, 59.0 percent of which was female. For both sexes, there are more cattle aged 2 years and above (105,117 for males and 154,992 for female cattle). Maseru had the highest number of cattle (59,029) followed by Leribe (56,094) while Qacha's Nek was the least with 1,303 cattle.


**Figure 3: Number of Cattle ('000), 2015/2016 to 2019/2020 Agricultural Years**

Figure 3 portrays cattle distribution from 2015/2016 to 2019/2020 Agricultural Years. There had been a decline in the heads of cattle from 2015/2016 to 2019/2020. The highest decline of 20.5 percent was observed in 2018/2019 Agricultural Year from 453,297 of 2017/2018. It further shows that in 2019/2020 Agricultural Year, 8.3 percent decline was observed from 360,602 of 2018/2019.

Table 10 shows percentage distribution of cattle by district, type and main purpose of keeping cattle. According to the table most cows were kept for meat (83.5 percent) while 15.2 percent were kept for draught power. About 52.5 percent of oxen were kept for meat. Furthermore, Mafeteng had 41.8 percent of draught power cows, followed by Maseru with 28.7 percent. It further shows that Berea had most bulls (21.3 percent), followed by Maseru and Leribe with 20.5 and 15.1 percent respectively.

### 2.2.2 Cattle Mortality

Mortality refers to deaths due to diseases. Table 11 shows cattle mortality by district and type of diseases for 2019/2020 Agricultural Year. It is shown that a total of 7,158 cattle died due to various diseases of which most deaths occurred in Berea (2,060) and least deaths occurred in Quthing and Qacha's Nek (97). Most cattle had


died due to anaplasmosis (2,119), of which Leribe experienced the highest deaths of 635.

Figure 4 depicts the trend for cattle mortality. It is shown that from 2015/2016 to 2018/2019 Agricultural Year, mortality had been decreasing but increased in 2019/2020. The highest deaths were experienced in 2015/2016 (11,260 cattle) and thereafter they declined by 54.5 percent to 7,289 deaths in 2016/2017, followed by a decrease of 2.7 percent in 2017/2018 and 7.1 percent in 2018/2019 Agricultural Year. In 2019/2020, deaths increased by 4.7 percent to 6,956 deaths.

### 2.2.3 Cattle Stock Change

Table 12 shows the percentage distribution on the change in stock of cattle. According to the table, there had been decline in stock of cattle for all districts except Mafeteng which has increased by 7.4 percent. The highest decline was in Qacha's Nek (93.3 percent) followed by Quthing with 27.8 percent.

### 2.3 Sheep Inventory

Sheep inventory entails distribution of Sheep, their mortality and stock change. Sheep age groups are classified into less than one year and those one year and above.

#### 2.3.1 Sheep Distribution

Table 13 shows sheep population by district, age and sex for 2019/2020 Agricultural Year. As shown by the table, a majority of sheep was female and aged 1 year and above (323,021). Maseru had the highest number of sheep (123,244) followed by Thaba-Tseka with 107,670. Qacha's Nek had the least number of sheep with 913.

Figure 5 shows the flock of Sheep for five consecutive Agricultural Years. It is observed that from 2016/2017 Agricultural Year, the number of Sheep had been decreasing. In 2016/2017 to 2017/2018 decreases by 21.0 percent and further decreased by 4.6 percent in 2017/2018 to 2018/2019. A tremendous decrease of 146.0 percent was experinced in 2019/2020.

**Figure 5: Number of Sheep ('000), 2015/2016 to 2019/2020 Agricultural Years**





Figure 6 describes the distribution of rams and hammels for 2019/2020 Agricultural Year. There were more hammels (84.3 percent) than rams. Improved rams constituted 4.8 percent while indigenous rams constituted 11.0 percent.

**2.3.2 Sheep Mortality**

Table 14 shows sheep mortality by type of disease. During the year, 70,674 sheep died due to diseases and most of them were in Berea (17,006). The table also shows that most sheep (14,059) died to Pulpy Kidney.

### 2.4.1 Goats Distribution


Table 16 presents number of goats by district, age and sex during the 2019/2020 Agricultural Year. According to the table, there were 628,561 sheep, 67.7 percent of which was female. Most of the goats were aged 1 year and above for both sexes with 135,527 and 346,128 for males and females respectively. Maseru had a largest number of goats (123,25) while Qacha's Nek had the least with 1,712 sheep.

## 2.4.3 Goats Stock Change

### 2.5.1 Pigs Distribution


Improved pigs include large white, land race, large black and duroc. Table 19 shows the number of pigs by district and breed for the 2019/2020 Agricultural Year. As observed in the table, there were 36,400 pigs of which 91.8 percent was improved. Duroc pigs were more popular than other pigs with 9,777, followed by Large black with 8,699 pigs. Large white pigs had a smallest number with 2,921. Maseru recorded a highest number of pigs (5,885) followed by Berea (5,848) while Botha-Bothe was lowest with 3,365 pigs. Maseru had a largest number of indigenous pigs with 1,258.

Figure 8 shows trend of pigs for the past five consecutive Agricultural Years. It is observed that from 2015/2016 to 2016/2017, the number of pigs had been declining, in 2016/2017 to 2017/2018, the number of pigs increased by 27.4 percent, and increased by 8.6 percent in 2018/2019. In 2019/2020, the number declined by 47.0 percent.

### 2.6.1 Horses Distribution


The distribution of horses by district, sex and age is shown in Table 21. Out of the 43,000 horses in 2019/2020, 47.8 percent were female. A majority of horses were aged 2 years and above for both males and females with 19,637 and 16,870 horses respectively. ## 2.6.3 Donkeys Distribution



### 2.7.1 Chicken Distribution



Figure 11 portrays chicken distribution for five year period. It has been shown from the previous table that indigenous chicken were more in numbers than the improved. There had been an increase of improved chicken (72.7 percent) in 2016/2017 from the previous year, which was followed by an increase of 146.5 percent in 2017/2018. As for the indigenous chicken, there had been an increase of 46.5 percent in 2016/2017 followed by declines of 16.1 percent in 2017/2018 and 17.4 percent in 2018/2019. In 2019/2020, the indigenous chicken increased by 1.6 percent.
